## Featured Saint of the Week

**St. Josephine Bakhita (1869–1947)**

**Feast Day: February 8**

Josephine was born into a Sudanese family on the outskirts of nobility, living a comfortable life until she was abducted by slave traders; at just seven years old.

Once taken, she had to walk over 600 miles to the city of El-Obeid. She was bought and sold at least a dozen times in the next 12 years. During her captivity, she was repeatedly tortured with beatings, and one owner literally carved patterns onto her body. While enslaved, she actually forgot her given name. Kidnappers gave her the Arabic name of Bakhita, which means lucky or fortunate. She was also forced to convert to Islamic beliefs, what we know today as the Muslim religion.

She was finally given as a gift to a family in Italy working as a nanny to the children of the house. The mistress of the house needed to travel to Sudan, but because of her history there, Josephine refused to go. The mistress placed her in the custody of the Canossian Sisters in Venice. But when the mistress returned, Josephine didn't want to leave the sisters because she had come to know God. The situation was taken before a judge, who ruled that since slavery had been outlawed before Josephine was even born, that she was now free to make her own decisions.

Josephine was baptized and received all of the sacraments of initiation from Cardinal Giuseppe Sarto, the future Pope Pius X.

She entered the convent as a novice, receiving her final vows in 1896. She took the spiritual name Josephine Margaret Fortunata. For 42 years, she worked in the convent; she also traveled to other convents sharing her story with those who were preparing to go work in Africa.

In her later years she was confined to a wheelchair; she died February 8, 1947.

During WWII, she's credited with answering prayers and saving her town from being bombed. Her life illustrates an exemplary love for and faith in Jesus.
