Featured Saints of the Week

St. Julie Billiart (1751-1816) Feast Day: April 8

Julie Billiart was born in Culvilly, France, and lived a relatively comfortable life. She excelled in her studies, especially her faith studies. She felt the need to pass on her faith and knowledge



to poor young girls. She wanted to become a teacher. But first, Julie entered the monastery to become a Carmelite nun.

While at the monastery Julie had a vision of the crucified Christ, who told her that she was to found a new religious congregation, to be named the Sisters of Notre Dame. In 1794, she met Sr. Francois Blin de Bourdon. Sr. de Bourdon became Julie's close friend and co-founder, combining their skills to establish a new congregation: the Sisters of Notre Dame. Their work was dedicated to the care and education of poor young girls.

In 1781, the French Revolution began, and for the next 10 years, all clergy and nuns were in constant danger. It was after a group of 16 nuns was beheaded that Julie knew it was time to get out. Under the cover of night, Julie, with other nuns and a few priests, traveled to Amiens, France to escape the danger and re-establish their school. In Amiens, the Monsignor and Julie didn't always agree, so she was "asked" to find a new place for their home. They next settled in Namur, Belgium, where they still operate today as the Sisters of Notre Dame Namur.

For 22 years of her life, Sr. Julie worked while a bed-ridden paralytic; for part of that time she was also rendered mute. Obviously, it didn't stop her. But in 1816, Sr. Billiart became ill; after three months, she succumbed, dying at the age of 64 in Namur on April 8, 1816. She is known as the smiling saint.

Trip to Italy 2025

Some of the parishioners who walked the Camino de Santiago this year plan to walk the Saint Francis Way located in Italy, which is a 300-mile walk. They will fly out on Tuesday, April 22, two days after Easter. The walk begins in Florence, Italy, and will go through the towns of Siena, Perugia, Assisi, and Rome, and many other small villages in between. Some side trips include Naples, Pompeii, San Giovanni Rotondo (where St. Padre Pio spent most of his life), Loreto (where the house of Mary is located), Turin (where the Shroud of Turin is located), Cascia, Lanciano, Venice, and Padua. Several of the towns we will visit are locations of Eucharistic miracles. 2025 is a Jubilee year; therefore, we hope many other sites will allow tours.

It would be great to have to have a priest join us on the pilgrimmage. If not the whole time, maybe for part of it. If anyone knows of a priest who may be interested, please reach out to them.

You have the option to walk every day, or if needed, arrange transportation to the next destination. English speaking tours are included in many of the major cities. Luggage will be transported daily to the next location. Ground transportation and hotels are all arranged. The length of the trip is approximately 27 days, and an approximate cost is around \$5200 per person, plus air fare. For a firm price, we need to get a count of the total number of people who want to walk the Saint Francis Way.
