Featured Saint of the Week St. Blessed Maria Rendiles Martinez

8/11/1903 - 5/9/1977 Feast Day 5/9

Maria was born the third of seven children in Caracas, Venezuela. She was born without a left arm, and used a prosthetic arm for the duration of her life. She'd always felt a calling to religious life.



In 1926 when religious representing the Servants of the

Eucharist arrived from France, she felt this was validation of her calling. Martinez applied and received permission to join the order. She was sent to Toulouse, France for novitiate training, receiving her habit in 1927. Her professional vows were pronounced in 1932. In 1945 she was appointed Superior for all of the congregation's houses in Venezuela. In 1965 she returned to Venezuela with the intention of founding an autonomous congregation. The new congregation was called the Servants of Jesus; they received diocesan approval from the Cardinal Archbishop of Caracas in 1969. She was appointed Superior General of the congregation, serving in that capacity until her death.

Additionally she established schools in Venezuela and Columbia to serve the poor and spread the faith. Her holistic view saw education as a transformative force, instilling values fostering character and empowering individuals through faith and knowledge.

Martinez was originally set to be canonized in June 2025 however, after Pope Leo's XIV's election he rescheduled the canonization service for October 19, 2025. St. Maria Rendiles Martinez will be the first female saint from Venezuela.




