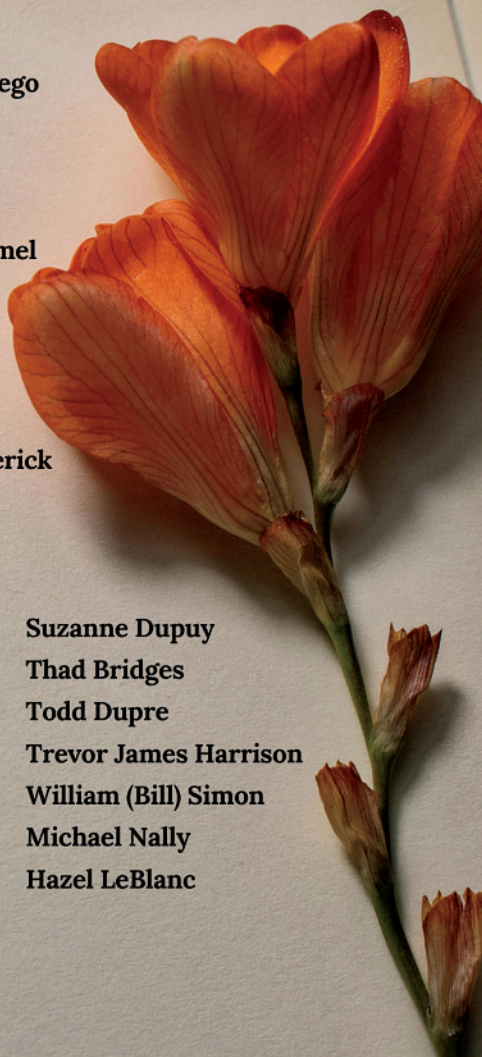

Featured Saint of the Week

St. Peter To Rot (3/5/1912-7/7/1945)
Feast Day 7/7



Peter was born in Papua, New Guinea in the southwest Pacific Ocean to a village chief and his wife, who were fervent Catholic converts since 1898. He was taught the basics of the Catholic catechism, and then sent to the local mission school. His father chose for him to first become a catechist before training for the priesthood, and so, he began training.

Once he was commissioned as a catechist and received his catechist cross, he was assigned to return to his home parish to assist Fr. Laufer. His knowledge and skills helped him to become an excellent teacher, and he always carried his Bible with him.

It was March of 1942 when Japanese forces took over the nation. Initially, they did not prohibit religious practice. However, when Fr. Laufer was forced to leave the village, he asked Peter to take charge of the parish, which entailed caring for the ill and the poor, as well as continuing to educate Christian converts.

The end of 1943 brought about restricted religious services until they were completely forbidden a few months later. Peter continued to hold secret services despite the potential dangers. He continued to pray with others and maintained records of baptisms and marriages. He was ordered to cease any and all pastoral activities. Eventually, he was reported for practicing the faith and was arrested. It was Christmas Day in 1944 when he admitted to police chief Mishida that he had been preaching.

While held in a concentration camp, Peter told his mother, "The police told me that this evening a Japanese doctor will come to give me some medicine. This is surprising since I'm not sick. I suspect this is a trick." He told his wife to bring him his cross and his best clothes so that he could face God dressed in proper attire. His death was unnecessarily crude and painful.

Peter To Rot was canonized on October 19, 2025, for his life's work and because he was "killed in hatred of the faith."
