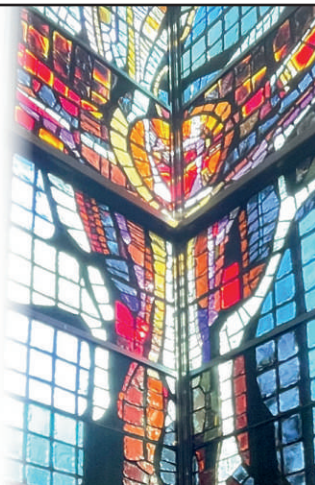

Featured Saint of the Week

St. Bartolo Longo (1841-1926) Feast Day 10/5

Bartolo was born into a wealthy family in the Kingdom of the Two Sicilies. Both of his parents were devoutly Catholic; his father died when he was 10. Already a mischievous child, his father's death put him into a tail spin. He was very smart but felt lost. This feeling of emptiness reached its peak while he was in college studying law. He'd given up on God and begun seeing local mediums for guidance. He dipped his toes into the occult and began practicing Satanism. He preached boldly and blasphemously against God and the Church. This went on for about a year until Bartolo realized he still felt an emptiness. He sought out Professor Vincenzo Pepe, a solidly Catholic professor at the university. The professor convinced him to seek counsel with a Dominican priest. After weeks of lengthy conversations, Bartolo was welcomed back into the Church and given absolution on the feast of the Sacred Heart.

His self-imposed penance was to work daily at the Hospital for the Incurables; he prayed and became a Third Order Dominican. God helped him to see how he could be saved and how he could spend his life saving others. He decided to start promoting the rosary and imitating the mysteries it contained. With local support, he built Pompeii's famous Basilica of Our Lady of the Most Holy Rosary. He founded schools and orphanages. He was also instrumental in the movement that led to the solemn dogmatic proclamation of the Assumption in 1950.

His most lasting contribution of all would probably be the Luminous Mysteries of the Rosary. It was from Blessed Bartolo's writings that Pope St. John Paul II found the idea of the mysteries covering the time of Jesus' public ministry, but also what the individual mysteries should be and what all five as a whole should be called.

Longo was nominated for the Nobel Peace Prize twice.

St. Bartolo Longo was canonized on October 19, 2025.

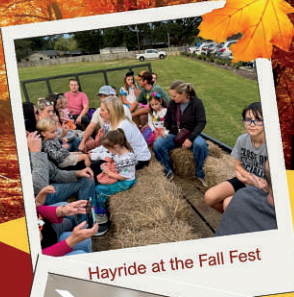
